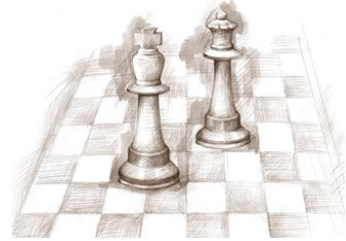
First round begins at 10:00 a.m.
