It is a prayer event that occurs over the month of May and again over the month of October, since those two months are dedicated to Our Lady and the Rosary, where people from all around the world participate by saying a Rosary every day for 40 days to end abortion in our country and in our world. This next 40 Days for Life Rosary Campaign starts September 27 and ends November 5.

We will have a poster hung in the school displaying the 200 decades of the Rosary that will be said in these 40 days and are asking all those individuals and groups who would like to participate to sign up to say a specific decade of the rosary on a specific day. This will be 40 Rosaries said by the people and groups that make up St. Patrick School.

A decade can be said by a student from any grade (young students encouraged since this is the best way they can get involved in this very serious issue), a teacher, an administrator, a sports team, an elementary class, a high school math class, a group of friends in middle school, a lunch group... whoever or in whatever combination with the understanding that at some point on the designated day, the person or persons would take 3 minutes to say the decade of the Rosary that they signed up to say.
