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- **A.D. Report** (Pat Russman)
 - Varsity Volleyball districts will be held in Ashley, we play on Nov 4th.
 - Varsity Cross Country will take place at Vandercook Lake.
 - 5/6 flag football program has wrapped up, there were 9 participants. Thank you to Ken Cook for heading the program.
 - Volunteers are needed for the Cross Country meet on October 21st at Portland Country Club. There is a need for more than 2 porta-johns. Expenses will be split between the Athletic Association account and the cross country account. The paint lining machine will be used to line the course.
 - 5/6 volleyball will start their tournament on October 17th. We will host games on Oct 24th and will need to hire an official for that day. The championship game is Oct 25th at LCC.
 - Winter sports sign up will take place the next two weeks.
 - JH boys basketball for the CYAC league can start practice Oct 26th. Make sure to have physicals done and turned in.
 - Gym updates: Money for the gym went towards the volleyball holes, with the additional money towards the net system. We have purchased a fully adjustable system with additional funds from the volleyball account. The cost was higher than expected, and there was much discussion on what was voted on and approved with regards to a 3rd pole and 2-net system. The Athletic Association is requesting firm quotes in the future, so we are all clear on what is being voted on and approved. The options for the 3rd pole and 2-net system will be revisited before the next volleyball season.

Old Business:

- **Fall Fest updates:** Carol stated everything is going well. They have more crafters than expected, so they had to ask for more classroom space. There are at least 15 more core workers that are needed, AA members are expected to sign up. There will also be a table with bleacher benches for sale.
- **Scrap metal drive:** Volunteers are still needed to work on Saturday Oct 17th from 9 - 2. Todd will try to get a list of what is accepted. Refrigerators will not be accepted, but there was some discussion on the Consumers program that will pay for refrigerators in working condition and they will handle the freon removal.
- **Cake walk:** The next cake walk will be at the football game on Friday Oct 16th. Volunteers are welcome to bring cakes or other baked goods.
- **Football field cleanup:** Todd said the field will need to be cleaned up Saturday, Oct 24th at 9 AM, please help if you can.
- **Father Flohe rebuild:** Todd stated they are working on conceptual plans for a replacement building. The insurance request came to \$277,000 and \$155,000 has been granted. They are close to finalizing the promotional video and are hoping to share the video later in the month. The video and website will be for anyone to share and promote, to reach out for assistance beyond the community.

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New Business:

- **Cross Country invitational needs:** Todd said they are looking for volunteers for the cc invitational on Oct 21st. Please contact Dan Lawless if you are able to help.
- **Auction:** Amber Fogarty is the auction chairperson.
- **Fall Sports Banquet:** Pat has to check with Father and right now they are looking at the week of November 16th.
