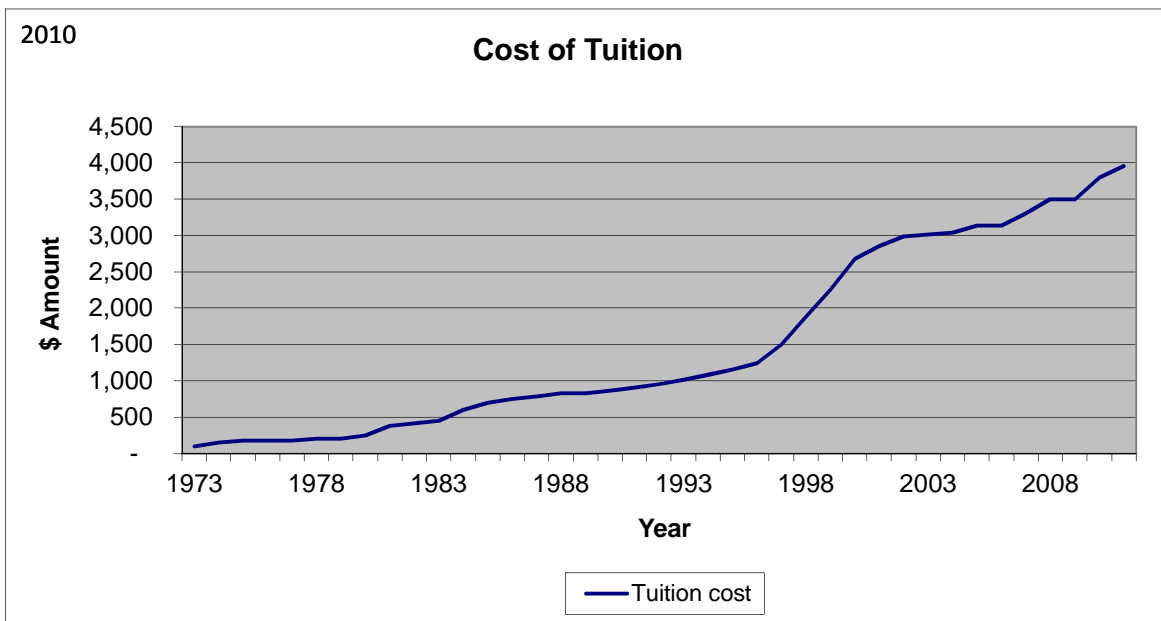
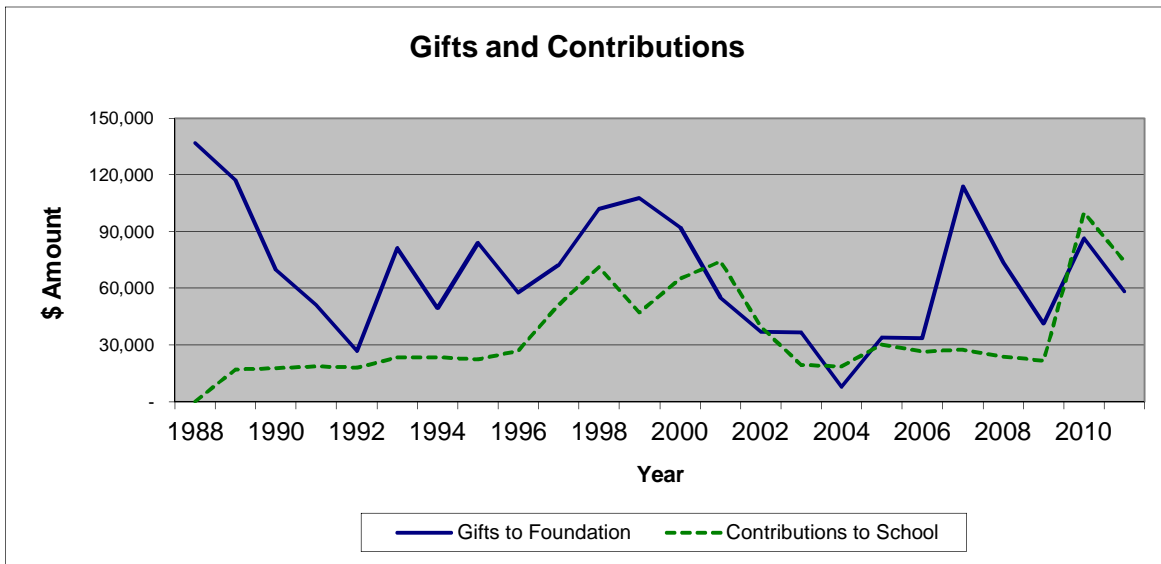


FATHER FLOHE FOUNDATION



As the graphs show above, the cost of educating children at St. Patrick School has risen significantly, particularly during the 1990's. Each year, the Father Flohe Foundation helps to offset some of this cost by providing funds to the school that are used to offset a portion of each student's tuition. Since 1989, the Foundation has contributed approximately \$858,000 in tuition assistance to the school. Imagine the impact the foundation could have if it grew to be 10 times the current size!

The Father Flohe Foundation accepts tax deductible contributions from donors and invests these funds in the financial markets. Through fiscal year ending 2010, the Foundation has received approximately \$1,625,000 in contributions from generous donors. During the mid to late 1990s, the Foundation made a plea to reach the \$1million dollar contribution level and successfully did so. Since that time, donations have generally fallen due to other projects and necessities of the Parish such as the church renovation, the school building addition and new boiler system.
